



































## Highe According to the CSD Education Survey National Aggregate Data Report

 According to the Annual Demographic & Employment Data 2019 Member & Affiliate Profile Employment Data 2019 Member & Affiliate Profile \* Race and Ethnicity, about 8.3% of ASHA members and affiliates identify as racial minorities, AND about 8.3% identify as Hispanic or Latino. In contrast, 27.8% of the U.S. population identify as racial minorities; 16.3% identify as Hispanic or Latino (U.S. Census Bureau, 2010).Of 196,023 ASHA Certified BJPs and AUDs reported in 2019, 6,137 identify as black (3%).
















Require a multicultural class within coursework (Undergrad/Grad) Offer incentives for further leisure/ recreational multicultural educational activities (museums, performances, etc.)
